Responding to the 2020 Census is an easy, safe, and important way to help provide resources for children and their communities for the next 10 years. This includes support for programs such as health insurance, hospitals, childcare, food assistance, schools and early childhood development.

Data collection begins March 2020 and continues through August 2020. You will receive a letter with instructions for completing the census beginning in March 2020.

How can I respond to the Census?

1. Online, using the internet or a smartphone,
2. Over the telephone, by calling the census call center listed on the census letter,
3. Using a paper form, or
4. By responding to a census worker at your door.



If you need help or access to a computer, visit any public library in Johnson County or call United Way 2-1-1. Census forms are available in 13 languages. Language guides (video and print) are available in 59 non-English languages as well as American Sign Language, braille and large print.
